ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The show grounds at this show constitute the show building area and parking around building.

The match site will be available to exhibitors from 3:00 pm until 7:00 pm Saturday, March 17, 2012. Dogs and equipment must be removed from the match site immediately following the match.

All parking is subject to control of the show-giving club. Park **ONLY** in designated areas. Vehicles must be moved from the Loading Zone within 15 minutes. **UNATTENDED VEHICLES IMPROPERLY PARKED WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.**

Trash receptacles will be located at regular intervals and each exhibitor is responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming and crating areas.

GROOMING AREAS - Grooming is restricted to designated areas. Space must be conserved and crates stacked wherever possible. The match committee has the right to review and condense crating space. There will be no exercise pens allowed in the grooming area

CLEAN UP

Exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on all parts of the show grounds.

Only dogs that are to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show grounds except dogs engaged as a special attraction approved by the American Kennel Club, may also be present.

Unentered Dogs shall not be benched, offered for sale or breeding or displayed. These dogs shall be subject to all American Kennel Club rules & regulations. The owners or agents shall be responsible for the care and safety of such dogs. Puppies under six months of age will not be allowed on the show grounds.

NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN REST ROOMS.
